

OMGS Board Meeting  
March 10, 2011

Board Members Present: David Read, Bill Chaney, Tim Wolfe, Donna Dove, Darla Wood, Janice Mobley.

Donna Dove called the meeting to order, with a quorum present.

Minutes: The minutes of the January board meeting were read by Bill Chaney. (No board meeting was held in February.) Darla Wood moved and David Read seconded that the minutes be accepted as read. Approved.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer's report was read by Bill Chaney. The report will be filed for future audit.

Correspondence: We have received newsletters, and some correspondence for board officers was delivered at the meeting.

New Member Applications: We have received new member applications for Couch, Eskew, Bruecks. Darla Wood moved and David Read seconded that we accept these new members; motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Old Business:

We received confirmation of last year's audit. David Read was commended for his good work.

New Business:
